

## Viewing Results in ORCA using a Time Frame

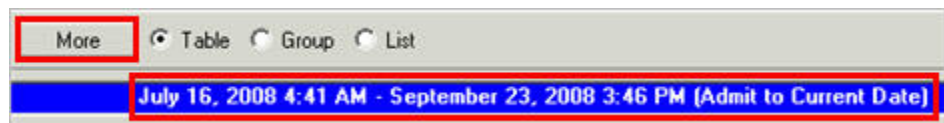
### Selecting a Time Frame instead of Result Count

- No matter what **time range** is selected, only **5000 results** will display at one time
- All **sections** with **flowsheets** have a display cap of 5000 results
- If more than 5000 results are available, the **MORE** button “lights up” and becomes available for selection
- Clicking on the **MORE** button will load up to 5000 more results

### Using the MORE button in ORCA

#### All Results menu item

- **Time Frame:** set the search criteria bar for a time frame, i.e. “Admit to Current Date”
  - The **MORE** button “lights up” if there are more than 5000 results available
  - Clicking on it will load up to 5000 more results
  - The **MORE** button stays grey if all results for the time frame chosen are already displayed



- **Result Count:** set the result count to a number up to 999
  - The **number of results requested is less than 5000**, so the **MORE** button is dithered (grey) and will **NOT** light up even if there are more results to view



- Click on the ► arrow to view 500 more results at a time

*Note: Recommended Default Setting is 500 Results. Do not set your default to Admit to Current Date.*
