

Charting Hemodialysis Access & Care

Adding a Hemodialysis/Peritoneal Dialysis Catheter to IVIEW

1. Click on the **IVs/Wounds/Tx** band
2. Click on the **Customize View** icon
3. Click on the **Collapse All** button



4. Use the scroll bar to get to the **DIALYSIS/ PERITONEAL ACCESS DATA**

5. Click in the **Default Open** boxes for both the **DIALYSIS/ PERITONEAL ACCESS DATA** and whichever catheter/access type your patient has (in the picture **NON-Tunneled Dialysis Cath** has been selected).
6. Click **OK** to close the **Customize View** window

Note: At HMC catheters can be NON-Tunneled, or Tunneled regardless of catheter type (Mahurker, Quinton, etc.). Please verify with Provider if line is tunneled or not.

Charting Assessments and Care of Dialysis Catheter

After you customize your **IVs/Wounds/Tx** band, you can document on the patient's dialysis access.

1. Double-click on the **blue (yellow) bar** to activate the section
2. Select the boxes that indicate the catheter location and number of lumens
3. Click **Other** and type "Started..." and the date and time line was inserted

Adding Documentation for AV Fistula/Graft to IVIEW

1. Click on the **Detailed Assessment** band
2. Click on the **Customize View** icon



Adding Documentation for AV Fistula/Graft to IVIEW (Cont.)

3. Click on the **Collapse All** button and scroll to the bottom of the window.

4. Click the **Default Open** box for **Dialysis #1 Fistula/Graft Access Data**



5. Click **OK** to close the **Customize View** window

Charting Assessment and Care of AV Fistula/Graft

After you customize the **Detailed Assessment** band, you can document on your patient's AV Fistula.

1. Double-click on the **blue (yellow) bar** to activate the section

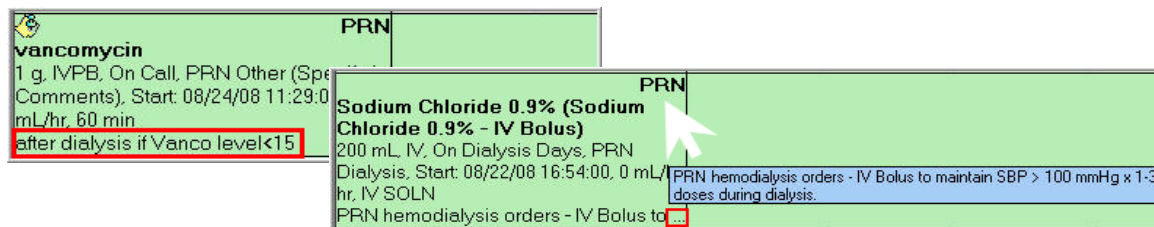
2. Chart the **Location**, the Assessment of the **Fistula graft**, **Site Appearance** and any **Care/Treatment** done for the fistula/graft



*Note: If you customize and chart on an AV Fistula in the **Detailed Assessment** band, the information will flow to the **Orthotics/CMS Circulation** band as well. The **Location** information will copy forward every time this section is activated for charting.*

Medications with Dialysis Instructions

During your OR/Procedure Handoff, review all medications with the Dialysis RN. Dialysis patients have specific needs regarding when certain medications are administered. The **Medication Order** in **Med Admin** states if a drug should be given pre-, post-, or during dialysis.



*Note: If the order contains "...", hover your mouse cursor on the order to read the entire comment. "On Call" medications are found in the **Unscheduled** band in **Med Admin**.*
