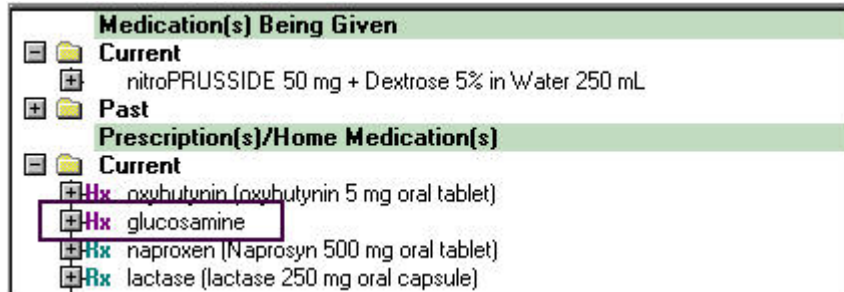
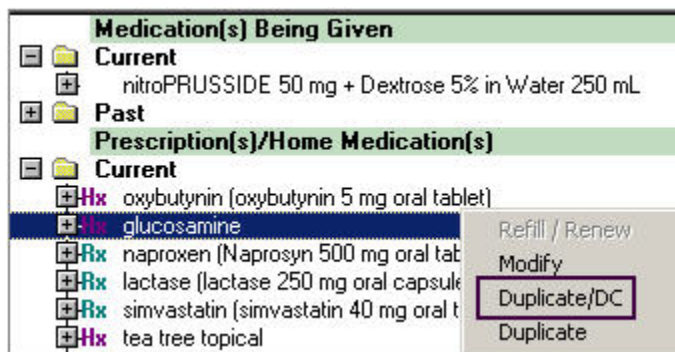


Change Historical Medication to Prescription

1. Open pt. chart, click on Med Profile
2. Right click the historical medication that is to be converted to a prescription.



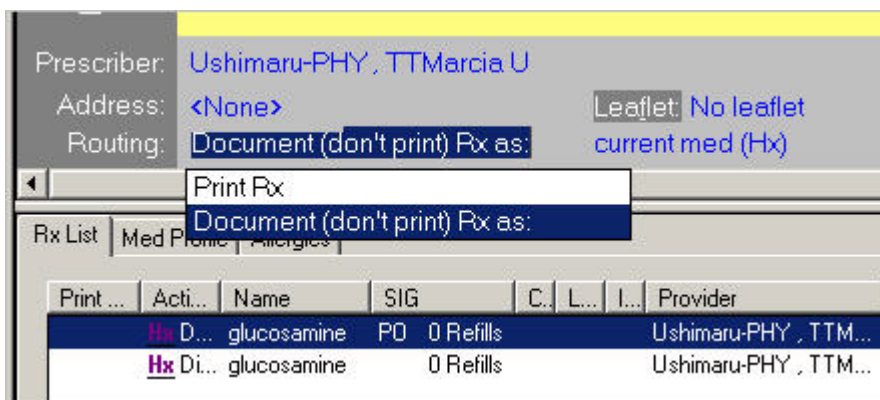
3. Click on **Duplicate/DC**.



Note that the medication appears as an Hx twice in the scratch pad.

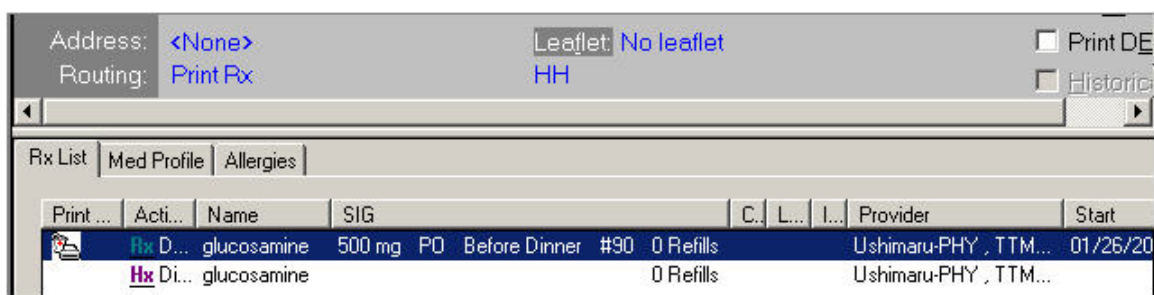
