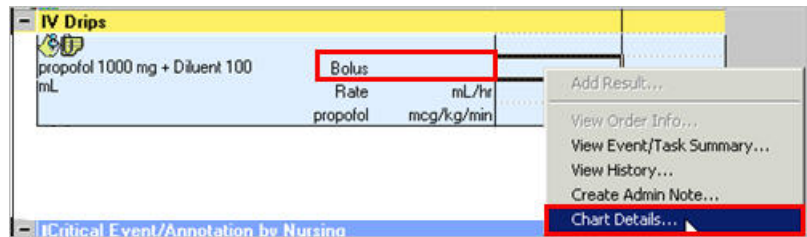


## Charting a Medication Bolus (Titratable Drips) – ICU

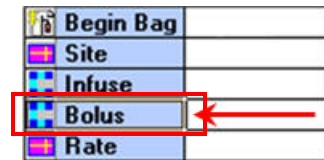
A new parameter called **Bolus** has been added to **IVIEW ICU Frequent Assessment** band. **Bolus** (from an existing drip) can be charted here. It will show **VOLUME** only (**ml**).

### Important steps when charting a medication bolus

- Remember, when a new bag is hung, chart **Begin Bag** in **Med Admin**
- If a **Bolus** is given from the existing titratable drip bag, then chart Bolus from the ICU Frequent Assessment band in IVIEW
  1. **Right Click** in the Bolus cell on the appropriate drip and select **Chart Details**. Charting window opens



2. Select **Bolus**, then fill in bolus volume field (yellow), review other information and change if necessary, **Apply** and sign.



3. Bolus volume will appear on the flowsheet.



### Other Tips for charting a medication bolus

If a **Bolus** is NOT given from the existing titratable drip bag, chart the Bolus on the separate medication order in **Med Admin** (example: Heparin – IV Push bolus taken from the PYXIS, not the hanging bag).

Chart rate changes on titratable drips in the **ICU Frequent Assessment band** in IVIEW. Chart these rate changes at the time of the change and at **0600, 1400, and 2200**. Once charted, this information will show in **Med Admin** and I & O.
