Medication Documentation	<u>Enhancement:</u> Initiate Button in PowerPlans Moving	Changes to PowerPlans Coming Monday Evening, October 19, 2009: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The PowerPlan Initiate button is moving next to the Sign button on the lower right corner of the window. The purpose of this change is to prevent staff from accidentally skipping the initiate step. ▪ A new PowerPlan banner will be added to identify the status of the PowerPlan phase. This is another visual tool to help staff know where they are in the PowerPlans ordering process.
	<u>Reminder:</u> Documenting Medication Administration After a Downtime	All medications administered during downtimes are to be documented in ORCA by the nurse who administered the medication. <i>NEW PROCEDURE:</i> If the nurse who administered the medication is no longer on duty, the nurse currently caring for the patient will address each Med Admin (MAR) overdue task by entering, "Downtime, See Paper MAR" in the Performed By field. See Downtime Recovery Medication Documentation poster for details. RNs are to use this procedure for all downtimes starting October 18, 2009.
Writing Notes	<u>Enhancement:</u> New Influenza-Like Illness Template	There is a new Influenza-Like Illness simple template in clinical notes which is associated with the Telephone Note. It is intended for use by primary care RNs. <i>Effective Thursday, October 15, late afternoon.</i>
	<u>Enhancement:</u> Smart Template Updates, Part Two	The second set of Smart Template updates is took place Tuesday, October 13. Thirteen Smart Templates were re-formatted to remove blue text and standardize font size.



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Other Information	<u>Enhancement:</u> ORCA Downtime	ORCA will be down for maintenance on Sunday, October 18, 0200-0400.
